DESIGN

From the colours & textures, to the sizing and design. We properly engineer your project so that it not only fits the code but also fits your desired aesthetic.



THE TIMBER

Our supply comes from the cast offs of the bigger logging outfits and saw mills in Western Canada that don't fit through their processors and would otherwise be wasted. We source oversize logs that are too large for production mills. This reduces the impact for additional logging for our timber requirements. Our timber frames come standard with premium tight grain FOHC Western Canadian Douglas fir. We also offer Canadian Western Red Cedar.



JOINERY

We use both traditional hand tools and modern machinery for timber frame joinery. The modern joinery ensures proper structural design and engineering, incorporated with the handcrafted traditional joinery which has been perfected and tested historically for over many centuries. These combined methods that are engineered, offer basically no design or timber size limitations for your project except the available timber itself.



CUSTOM MILLING

Environmental responsibility is important to us. Our inhouse system will mill the logs to the specs of your design while also making the most of every log. Any timber that does not meet grade during milling or that is waste we use for our large wood boiler facility heating requirements and any additional we sell as firewood for home heating.



FINISHING

Due to our handcrafted and modern technology we are able to offer very specialized textures and finishing exclusively from Timber Masters. Custom colours and diamond coat sealers ensure your timber is unique and protected for years to come.






























BOXBEAMS











Going with a Box Beam is perfect for renovation or DIY projects. They do not require structural support and can easily be cleated to many surfaces. We also have a product called an End Cap that comes in two different styles. This design gets installed on a Box Beam when the end is going to be exposed or when ordering a mantle.



FEATURES

1.Locking miters create tight and seamless joints for a realistic solid timber look.

2. We mill our stock on site from premium Canadian Douglas Fir and then we kiln dry the planks for increased stability after assembly and installation.

3. Polyurethane glue is used to ensure strong weather-resistant bonds in all joinery.

4.Baffles are glued and screwed with even spacing along the interior of each beam to increase strength and minimize twisting, cupping and cracking.

5. Optionally supplied cleats make installation easy and quick for seasoned professionals and DIYers alike.

6.Uninterrupted lengths up to 26FT are available, or for longer lengths (unlimited), add a scarf joint for an authentic timber framed look.

7.Optional end-grain caps can be added for a solid timber look on exposed box beam ends - great for mantels and large floating shelves.

8.Not shown - installing on an angled roof? We can cut the angle you require on your beams for an easier installation process

SHELVES

Timber Masters offers shelves in two different options: Hollow Floating & Solid, with any custom sizing. You can easily design our product to your own specifications such as texture and color.

Our Hollow Floating Shelves system comes with metal brackets that are easily installed to achieve the "floating" look. These come in a minimum 2.5" thickness and have a standard depth sizing of either 9.25" or 11.25".

The Solid Shelving are also completely customizable with a larger range of thickness & depths available starting at 1.5" thick.

All of our shelves are made with Canadian Douglas Fir and are hand-crafted at our Alberta location.



MANTLES


STAIRCASES




- 1. We use premium Western Canadian Douglas Fir & Western Red Cedar, with tight grain and free of heart for maximum long-term stability.






